Following on from the IPU Safe Pharmacy Initiative, we are introducing a new course on 1 July, titled 'Safe Pharmacy, Understanding Domestic Abuse and Coercive Control, Creating a Safe Environment for Disclosure'. This course is certified by the global awarding body ATHE (Awards for Training and Higher Education). The cost to complete this course is fully sponsored by the IPU and is available to all pharmacies registered as a Safe Pharmacy and has nominated a champion.

The course is broken down into 7 modules which can be completed over a period of time that suits each participant. This course is easily accessible from a mobile phone, and the time required to complete each module will be clearly indicated before it starts.
